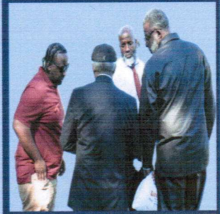
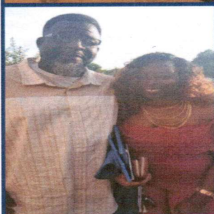
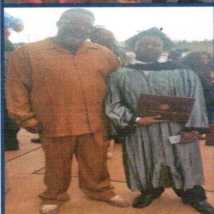
My "Punkin"
