You will walk with us forever.

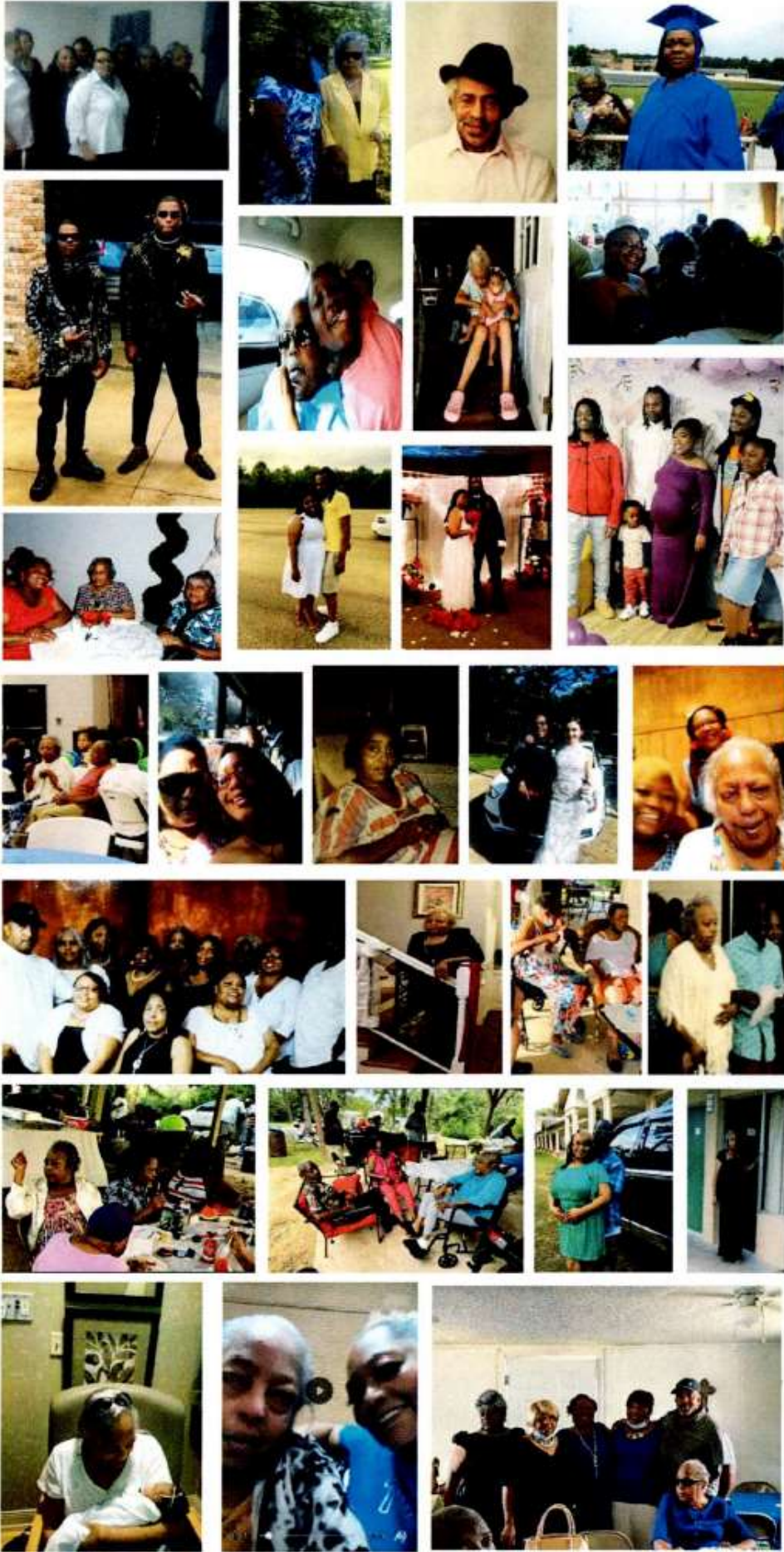
